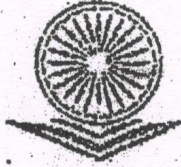

With reference to the proposal of following two Colleges received through Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli concurrence of the State Government of Tamil Nadu State given by its representative during the Screening Committee meeting held on 31-03-2006 at UGC for shortlisting of colleges of Tamil Nadu State, I am pleased to inform you that the Commission at its meeting held on 07-05-2007 considered the reports of UGC Expert Visiting Committee which visited these colleges affiliated to Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli as per dates noted against each. Based on the recommendation of the Expert Committee, the Commission has **AGREED** to grant autonomous status to the following two colleges for the period mentioned against each as under:-

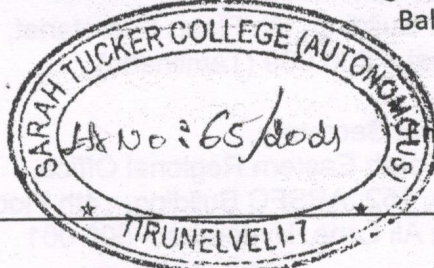

Sir/Madam,

This has reference to the proposal submitted by Sarah Tucker College (Autonomous), Tirunelveli-627 007 Tamilnadu affiliated to Manonmaniam Saundaranar University, Tirunelveli, Tirunelveli Rd, Abishekapatti, Tamil Nadu 627012 for extension of autonomous status under the UGC Scheme for Autonomous Colleges.

As per the decision of the Standing Committee constituted by University Grants Commission, in its meeting held on 12.04.2021, the Competent Authority has decided to extend the autonomous status to **Sarah Tucker College (Autonomous), Tirunelveli-627 007 Tamilnadu** affiliated to **Manonmaniam Saundaranar University, Tirunelveli, Tirunelveli Rd, Abishekapatti, Tamil Nadu 627012** for a period of Five (05) years from the session 2021-2022 to 2025-2026, including ex-post-facto approval from the period 2013-2014 to 2020-2021, as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.3 of UGC Regulations dated 12.02.2018.

The University is requested to issue necessary notification/order regarding extension of autonomous status to the College as per the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018 for Autonomous Colleges. The College, if eligible, shall apply for autonomy grant as per the norms laid down in the Regulations.

The Autonomous College is required to abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges. The Regulations are available on the UGC website, www.ugu.ac.in. Non compliance of the requirements and conditions in the said Regulations shall attract action as per Clause -14 of the UGC Regulations - 2018. Further, it may be noted that the above said college shall also apply in the prescribed format to University Grants Commission for extension of autonomous status six months prior to the expiry of the autonomous cycle.


